

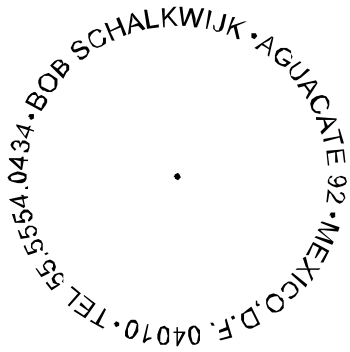
## Curriculum Vitae, Bob Schalkwijk
